-Operator Report. Fixed Line screen and reprogrammed autodialer, collected flow numbers, inspected lagoon, submitted paperwork to ecology and DMR, Found breaker tripped in fine screen reset and ran thru paces did not trip again collected samples sent to lab. Collected and delivered all groundwater samples. Need to get a special rake for removing sludge, Nathan will look into this.

Signed resolution for Kris Hansen or Rod Griggs to handle investment.C/Carasco MM, C/Bleecker 2nd passed unanimously.

It was decided that installs would go thru district not privately. Discussed inventory and need to have 2 pumps and 2 tanks on hand, extra pipe and saddles.

A resolution for the commissioners to get a \$90 stipend for meetings was presented and C/Carasco mm to accept 2nd by C/Bleecker motion passed unanimously

The pros and con statements for the levy were discussed and it was decided to go from last years con statement and Grant is going to do the Pro statement..

C/Carasco MM and C/Bleecker 2nd to accept the repair est on the irrigation pump. Motion Passed. Unanimously Motor needs to be located. Nathan to look into this.

.Found generator in alarm and called Cummins, Est to trouble shoot is 1,641.00. C/Carasco MM to go ahead with the estimate C/Bleecker 2nd and it motion passed unanimously

Irrigation 50 acres of PVC needs to be inspected and a report on broken pipes. Ecology wants pipes moved around and we need to start irrigation before next meeting. We need to see if any of this would be covered by insurance from falling trees.

Lagoon needs the sludge to cleaned out. Nathan has a pump truck that charges \$175.00 an hour.

We have 26 stubs with an M&O of 23.50 each.a month and there is no maint needed on the stubs so C/Carasco MM to alleviate the charge and C/Bleecker 2nd motion passed unanimously. Now stub fee will be 117.49 instead of 140.99.

There was a discussion regarding volunteers and if it goes thru us we have to have L&I on them. Need further discussion on this, possibly see if we can transfer to the landowners for a new agreement. This is the Sterling Johnson agreement.

We need to try to find another Beaver mitigation as the other one did not show up and is not available until Mid July.. Will try Quinton 671-1217

-Public Comment. Wendy Newlun it is taking 6 months to update indistinct and out of district map to get updated in the county records.
