Materials accepted at the Clean Green Rate of \$10 minimum* up to 300 lbs. or \$55 per ton + \$2 EPC per vehicle:

- Bark, weeds, twigs, pine needles, pine cones
- Food and food-soiled paper
- Grass clippings
- Leaves and other foliage
- Limbs not more than 6 feet long and 3 inches in diameter
- Sod not more than 3 inches thick (shake off all rocks and extra soil)

Materials accepted at the Garbage Rate of \$17 minimum* up to 280 lbs. or \$114.00 per ton + \$2 EPC per vehicle:

- Garbage
- Limbs more than 6 feet long or 3 inches in diameter
- Tree trunks, stumps & root balls under 10" diameter
- Construction and demolition debris, Lumber
- Camper shells with appliances removed
- Concrete, Dirt, Gravel/Rocks
- Mattresses and other furniture
- Residential appliances (Refrigerators with <u>ammonia</u> are not accepted. Commercial sized appliances not accepted)
- Tires (tires greater than 36" diameter must be cut in two foot pieces, limit 6 tires per visit)
- Animal carcasses (< 20 lbs), Animal feces (<10 lbs)
- Hot tubs

Mixed loads of garbage and clean green must go through the scales twice and will be charged two different rates.

Recyclables may be dropped off for free in the Recycling area:

- Scrap metal- must be easily unloaded by resident
- Push or riding lawn mowers and snow blowers (fluids removed)
- Metal boats less than 16' or cut in half
- BBQs with plastic parts removed
- Glass bottles and jars
- Newspaper, magazines, junk mail and office paper
- Any plastic containers labeled 1 and 2 except plastic bags, wraps, and films
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Clothing and intact books (Orange Global Neighborhood Thrift Bin)
- Household paint (interior, exterior, latex, oil based)

Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site open Saturdays & Sundays. (Limit 15 gallons per visit)
